# 41<sup>st</sup> Medical Students Exchange Program in Xitou, Taiwan 9-13 August 2012

Around 100 christians consisting mainly of medical students and doctors gathered together in a beautiful forest camp called Youth Activity Center in Xitou, Taiwan. Representatives from the Korean, Japanese & Taiwan

Christian Medical Associations, Chinese Christian Medical Mission(CCMM) & Christian Medical and Dental Fellowship (CMDF) Hong Kong were present. Their theme was: "Promoting Networking & Collaboration in Medical Missionary". Ms Tan Chiew Hwa and Dr Boey represented Healthcare Christian Fellowship International (HCFI). Dr Boey shared on the 'Value of Kingdom collaboration'. The students asked many questions relating to work balance and ministry. They were hungry for answers to difficulties in life. Lugging their suit-cases in the rain and across high speed rail stations were small inconveniences compared to the great joy they both experienced in the presence of His people, listening to testimonies of God's faithfulness to them.

### Community Health Evangelism (CHE) Training of Medical Students - 13-15 November 2012

Training in Community Health Ministry was conducted for a small group of 13 medical students. The latter were involved in project Sothea in Cambodia.CHE Trainer Dr Lim Su Min taught on the approach and transformation of livelihood and healthcare in rural communities.

### Hospital Visitation Seminar 8<sup>th</sup> December 2012

30 persons met on a Saturday afternoon in Level 8 of National University Health System. Trainers Drs Boey and Stephen Chang taught on the biblical perspective of Hospital Visitation and a



compassionate approach to patients. Participants were later divided into several groups for practical training in patient care. The participants were medical students and cell group members from various churches. They showed great enthusiasm and expressed gratitude for this preparatory course for the hospital outreaches.

Carolling was done for the first time in the new hospital of Mount Elizabeth Novena.

### Here are some testimonies:

"I had previously assumed that one person less makes little difference to the group of carollers. But I no longer because that one person, if fully surrendered to the Lord would be used by Him to minister to one lost sheep. Scriptures say "there is more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over 99 already saved" Luke 15:7. I sensed the angels hovering around us when we sang & prayed for the patients & I believe that others also felt the same.....hence the carollers weren't ready to stop, they wanted to go on and on......"

"In the short one hour I had with the team, we sang and prayed for 5 patients and many were in tears. The last patient we prayed for came across as someone desperately seeking healing, peace and truth. He told us he would believe if the Lord healed him of the nerve problem in his left hand. His honesty surprised me when he confessed that apart from his physical condition, he has suicidal thoughts. I wished we had more time to speak to him about the truth of God.
